It is a small gesture with heart-warming results and memories made that will last a lifetime.

This project began in 2007 with only three soldiers participating in the hunt and has grown each year in size to hosting six soldiers from Mississippi and Georgia for our 2010 hunt. It is our hope and expectation that this trend will continue.

Beginning Friday, January 7, 2011 Woods Wheels and Water Outdoors, Inc. will host it's 4th Annual Wounded Warrior Hunt at Camp Garawya in Clinton, Mississippi. Hunters will hunt various properties that have been provided by generous landowners within close proximity to the Clinton facility with a WWWO staff member and guide. Saturday's hunt will include a banquet style meal, with a key note speaker, door prizes and other activities planned.

While planning for this event is still taking shape and in an effort to provide these very deserving individuals with a memory they will cherish for many years to come, we are seeking partnerships to make the possibility of a weekend of fellowship and comrade a
